**Dear Members,**

I am happy to announce that we have passed our pool inspection and we will be opening our pool on July 11<sup>th</sup>. As expected a significant part of the pre-opening inspection focused on our Covid-19 protocol as well as the condition of the pool. Any one interested in the 12-page document we had to generate and supply to the Region of Peel can download it [here](#).

As I alluded to last week the operation of the pool will be a little different this year.

- Entrance and exit from the pool will be using separate gates, thus individuals will be entering by the normal entrance by the shower, and exiting the pool via the gates in the deep end. No two-way traffic allowed on the deck or by the shower entrance.
- A strict limit to the number of people that can be within the fenced area of the pool (Adults & Children);
  - Weekdays – no more than 30 people at one time
  - Weekends – no more than 57 people at one time.

lounging, sitting, sun bathing etc. Feel free to use areas outside the pool (grass areas) for these activities respecting social distancing.

- To give everyone an opportunity to use the pool we are imposing a 1 hour time limit. See the info graphic below on how this works.

We ask that all understand that these are the conditions imposed by Peel and the province. I ask that all work with the lifeguards to make this work smoothly. The Region of Peel does periodic inspections during the summer (at any time) and they have the mandate to close down the pool if we are not following the rules.

I ask that all be patient and we all work together as members of the Farma to make the most out of what we will be given for the 2020 season.



# Pool COVID-19 Protocol

Pool Occupancy Limits  
 Weekends: 57 bathers  
 Weekdays: 30 bathers



## Important Notes:

1. Entrance to the pool on the hour.
2. Entrance ONLY by the Shower area
3. Exit ONLY by the deep end
4. No Sitting, standing, lounging on the Deck area (gray areas on the map).
5. All bathers to sign in at the log book (anytime during their swim period)
6. No snorkels
7. Lifeguard storage area off limits
8. Masks shall not be worn in the water
9. Bathers will be asked to clear the pool area starting at 15 min to the hr.
- 10 Pool to be cleared prior to the hr to allow the next group of bathers in
- 11 Bathers to maintain 2m social distance unless part of the same family group
- 12 Bathers not following the rules will be asked to leave.

## Example of Timed Entry

- |         |  |

| 1:00 pm | Lifeguard allows bathers in until the maximum number has been reached (Gate closed once reached) |
|         | Bathers are to sign in at the log book during their swim period                                  |
| 1:45 pm | Lifeguard gives bathers 10 min warning the swim session ending                                   |
| 1:55 pm | Pool is cleared of bathers by this time  |
| 2:00 pm | Next group of bathers allowed to enter   |
